

Report: Regarding the completion ceremonies of the liquefied CO₂ onshore facilities of the R&D and Demonstration of CO₂ Ship Transportation Project

Japan CCS Co., Ltd., as a member of a consortium comprising four companies has been jointly commissioned by NEDO (New Energy and Industrial Technology Development Organization) to undertake the “R&D and Demonstration of CO₂ Ship Transportation Project”.

In conjunction with the completion of the onshore liquefied CO₂ facilities that have been under construction in Maizuru City, Kyoto and Tomakomai City, Hokkaido, completion ceremonies were held with the attendance of the relevant government agencies, NEDO, local governments and other parties involved, as well as the other joint contractors.

At this ceremony, we also held a ceremony to mark the first shipment of liquefied CO₂ by the transportation demonstration ship "EXCOOL", with the cooperation of one of the joint contractors, Nippon Gas Line Co., Ltd.

In cooperation with joint contractors and with the understanding and support of the local community, we will contribute to the establishment of an integrated transportation system that handles the loading, transport and receipt of liquefied CO₂, through the operation of both onshore facilities comprising equipment for CO₂ liquefaction, storage and loading/unloading.
